In Session 2025-26 our student Yashvi of X topped in the school by securing 96% marks, Gaganpreet got 93.8% marks and Rishav got 87% marks.

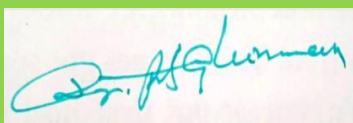
Along with education, the school pays special emphasis to the fact that our students should go ahead in co-curricular activities so that there is overall development of the personality of the students.
